It will be two years in November since Ofsted last inspected our school. We anticipate, and indeed welcome, a further inspection this academic year. All staff have worked incredibly hard to address actions from the previous inspection. Our aim is that parents fully understand the steps of progress school has made, and the final steps planned. School currently self-evaluates as Good with some Outstanding features. You will be aware from recent media reports that there will be changes to Ofsted's grading and ways of working.
